- Make your table tennis sessions more accessible to all.
- Communicate effectively with disabled people.
- Meet the individual needs of disabled people.
- Provide appropriate information about table tennis.

**GBWBA - Grade One Assistant
Wheelchair Basketball Coach
Monday 27 & Tuesday 28 June,
9am to 5pm**

The course lasts 16 hours, and is predominantly practical. This course is suitable for parents, teachers, physiotherapists, and players/ex players, who wish to assist in the introduction of the basic skills and game play of wheelchair basketball to juniors and beginners. It is a pre-requisite for the GBWBA Coach Award and Coaching Assistants must be aged 16+.

At the end of the course the Coaching Assistant will:

- Have knowledge and understanding of the core generic coaching skills.
- Have an awareness of conducting a safe session.
- Be able to plan and deliver a session introducing the fundamental skills of wheelchair basketball.
- Progress fundamental skills of wheelchair basketball into small sided game situations.
- Contribute to the evaluation of an activity session.

All participants will receive the GBWBA Grade 1 candidate pack containing guidance on all content covered on the course and Wheelchair Basketball Grade 1 Assistant Coach certificate.

Participants will be expected to have an on course tutor assessment and have a written plan, deliver and evaluate a short practical coaching session.

High Quality PE for Pupils with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

**Monday 9 May 2011,

A Youth Sport Trust workshop that shows teachers/coaches how to engage with pupils with ASD, by using adapted methods and coaching techniques in PE sessions. The tutor will deliver the course through a theory workshop, technical demonstrations and games.

- The day is open to teachers, classroom assistants and coaches who currently deliver PE or are interested in delivering PE to pupils with ASD.

Create Development Inclusion Conference

Tuesday 17 May, 9am to 3pm

The conference will focus on young disabled people's skills, opportunities and aspirations. Through a series of workshops, practitioners will explore the ways in which they can ensure all young people are challenged and empowered in a school setting.

Workshops will include:

- Physical Literacy – building the foundations needed to maximise independence and potential.
- Ensuring the Challenge – accelerating learning through assessment.
- Creating a Bridge into Clubs and Competitions – inspiring young sportspeople to share their dreams, journeys and career pathways.

Boccia Community/Regional Referee Courses (Levels 1 and 2)

Monday 23 May, 10am to 4pm

The courses aim to provide individuals with an understanding of the principles of boccia officiating and will explore the following areas:

- Terminology, roles and equipment
- Officiating: competition rules, management responsibility.
- Introduction to classification.

Raising the Bar Course

Tuesday 24 May, 10am to 3pm

This practical course builds on the multi-skill content of the 'FUNS for everyone' course and enhances understanding of multi-skills as a broad, balanced, child-centred approach to PE and Sport.

The course will:

- Demonstrate how to use the 'Raising the Bar' programme to include, challenge and support the 'whole child'.
- Explore the personal, physical, social, cognitive and creative development of children and young athletes.
- Introduce the 'Raising the Bar' resource and philosophy.
- Apply and personalise delivery to better include, challenge and support all children and young athletes.

The course is ideal for those delivering Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 3 curriculum, multi-skill clubs and gifted and talented academies. Expanding upon the original 'FUNS for everyone' programme, the resource includes 3 x 8 module schemes of work, providing a menu of sessions and activities linked to different abilities.

Sports Coach UK:

Inclusive Coaching – Disability

Monday 6 June, 10.30am to 2.30pm

This workshop focuses on the knowledge and skills required to enhance current coaching skills to make sessions more inclusive. Delegates have an opportunity to gain practical experience through involvement in a coaching session that requires the participation of disabled people.

It also covers the basic elements of disability sport classifications and pathways for disabled participants.

The course is especially aimed at qualified coaches with an interest in coaching disabled people.

Boccia Leaders Course

Tuesday 14 June, 9am to 1pm

The course covers:

- An Introduction to the game of boccia; basic rules and the interpretation of them.
- How to lead boccia sessions with an appropriately structured activity plan and in accordance with health and safety requirements.
- An awareness of the needs of individuals and the empowerment of all players.
- Teaching basic skill practices to players.
- How to introduce creativity and fun to sessions.
- An understanding of existing competitive structures to enable individuals to progress in the sport.
