The service is open to disabled children and young people aged 8-16, their friends and family, who are resident in Liverpool.

The project is aimed at supporting inclusive practices to enable disabled children and young people to access short breaks, such as sport and recreational opportunities alongside their peers, and to support the development of short breaks for severely disabled children and young people. Referrals to the project can be made directly to the project lead by parents, carers or professionals. Professionals making referrals to this project must be working to support the needs of the child or young person and their family and will need to seek agreement from them prior to making the application.
